Call for Applications – Tenure-Track Position

**Archaeological Biogeochemistry of the Levant  
and Neighboring Regions**

The School of Archaeology and Maritime Cultures (SAMC) at the University of Haifa, Israel, invites applications for a tenure track position in archaeological biogeochemistry of the Levant and neighboring regions, starting in October 2022. The newly established SAMC comprises the Departments of Archaeology and Maritime Civilizations with two new departments planned to be established within three years – Archaeological Sciences and Preservation, Heritage and Museology in Archaeology. The current position is intended for the Department of Archaeological Sciences.

We are seeking candidates with proven academic excellence in their fields of expertise. Specifically, we are looking for candidates with strong background in the archaeology and stable isotope biogeochemistry of the Eastern Mediterranean / Levant. Candidates should demonstrate hands-on research experience with stable isotope biogeochemistry related to reconstruction of diet, environment/climate, and mobility of humans and associated animal and plant taxa. Candidates are expected to show how their research is relevant for both inland and coastal settings and climatic zones typical of the eastern Mediterranean, as in the SAMC framework they are expected to conduct research in all these arenas.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. as well as post-doc research, with publications in prominent refereed journals. They must demonstrate excellence and originality in research and proven experience in field and laboratory/experimental projects. The position is open to all ranks.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach the equivalent of 8 semestrial hours of undergraduate and graduate-level courses. The primary teaching language is English. The candidate will be expected to supervise theses and carry usual nonteaching duties.
